Attorney General Todd Rokita:

Pursuant to Indiana Code 5-14-3-3, the Indiana Democratic Party is submitting a public records request to your office because news reports indicate there are clear conflicts of interest in your office. These conflicts should be publicly addressed to ensure that Hoosiers can have faith in the Office of the Indiana Attorney General and you, Indiana's top law enforcement officer.

In order to make sure your constituents understand the full scope of your professional relationship with Apex Benefits and your role as "advisor" to the organization, the Indiana Democratic Party is asking for the Office of the Indiana Attorney General to provide:

- The full advisory opinion that was issued by either Lori Torres, former Inspector General of Indiana, or the Indiana Office of Inspector General.
- Any and all communication between the Indiana Office of Inspector General, Ms. Lori Torres, and Attorney General Todd Rokita regarding the former Inspector General's advisory opinion on Mr. Rokita.
- Information regarding any state resources used in your role as an Advisor with Apex Benefits, including any communication using State of Indiana e-mail addresses.

Public trust in state government regulators is paramount in ensuring the integrity of our justice system. If that system appears to protect special interests at the expense of Hoosier families, it has failed the state. Taxpayers deserve the highest level of conduct and transparency from Indiana's top law enforcement officer, thus these requests are being made with the most efficient response timeline requested.

To that end, I look forward to your response.
